The Maestro Cares Foundation scholarship program provides financial support to academically talented and financially disadvantaged Latino/a students studying in both undergraduate and graduate programs in the United States, Puerto Rico, and Latin America.

We serve through two distinct pathways: individual scholarship recipients and university partnership agreements. All scholarship recipients are required to complete volunteer hours, as community service is integral to our philosophy at Maestro Cares Foundation.

Students who receive individual scholarships apply directly to our scholarship program and receive financial aid from Maestro Cares Foundation.

Students who receive scholarships through our university partnership agreements apply through their universities. Our university partners collaborate with us to identify, select, and support students enrolled in the partner university.

The Maestro Cares scholarship has **benefited over 150 students** in Latin America and the United States.

## *From Tierralta to Paris: Andrés's Journey to Improving Water Access and Quality Through Engineering*

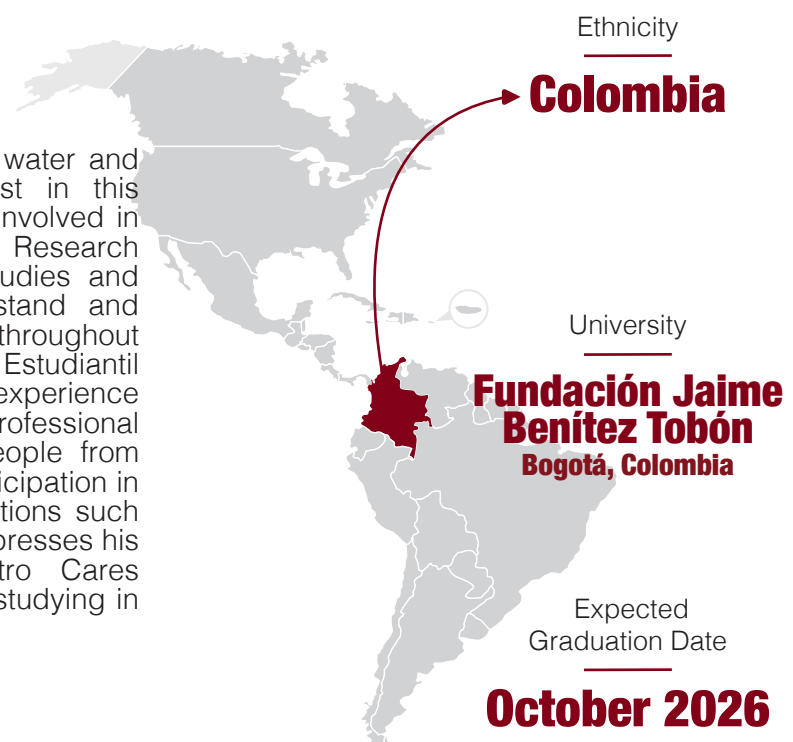

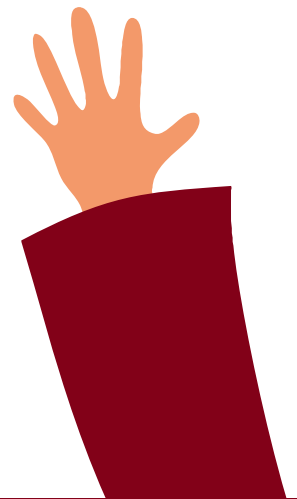
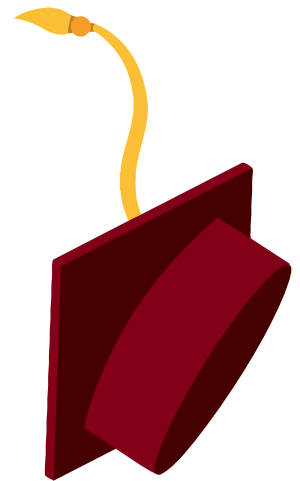
## GENDER DISTRIBUTION
