





COVID-19 RELIEF EFFORTS

Together, we have all faced the global threat of COVID-19. We have adapted and made adjustments to our daily lives and routines to protect ourselves and our loved ones from the COVID-19 virus. While the world entered an unprecedented struggle against COVID-19, we also witnessed compassion across all corners of the world.

Thanks to your support, Maestro Cares Foundation has stepped up to provide over \$100,000 in COVID-19 related response and recovery efforts. We provided communities across Latin America and the United States with critical PPE equipment, food, and technological equipment to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and to ensure that all children and adolescents continued learning without interruption.

Despite COVID-19, our momentum is stronger than ever. We remain fiercely committed to serving our children and communities and help maximize their opportunities for success.



PROUD PARTNER WHON

Established in 1998, the Eric D. Hovde and Steven D. Hovde Foundation focuses its support on caring for vulnerable children through its Hovde Home initiative. Hovde Homes provide shelter, supportive services, and love to vulnerable children in Latin America and Africa. They offer a haven from injustice, neglect, malnutrition, and other forms of abuse. Each house is operated by carefully selected, local organizations with professional experience providing appropriate cultural, physical, and psychological care for children in their community. In pursuit of their vision of a world where all children can smile, knowing they are safe, valued and loved, the Hovde Foundation has opened homes that care for over 500 children a year in 10 countries.

Maestro Cares Foundation and the Hovde Foundation have partnered on two initiatives to date. In February of 2019, we established Casa Hovde: Marta Bedoya de Claure in Bolivia. The home supports 30 youth and adolescents that are victims of trafficking, prostitution, and street violence. We are also working together to build a home in Costa Rica for up to 24 girls rescued from forced prostitution and sex trafficking. Both are places of refuge for girls to recover from their trauma and learn the tools they need to thrive.

"Our partnership with Maestro Cares on these projects allows us to expand our footprint and reach as many children as possible. Together, we are wholeheartedly committed to strengthening our communities by investing in youth and helping vulnerable children overcome their circumstances and grow into healthy, happy adults." - Eric Hovde, Hovde Foundation.
